Tu clase tu país was born out of the desire to contribute to the improvement of the educational systems of Latin America, betting on empowering and training teachers in an integral way.








Creation of Edu2pro model, consisting in developing a network of integral development for teachers through a digital platform. Later it will change its name to Docente al Día.
