2. Description

This diploma is aimed at teams of teachers and school leaders (at least three must be working at the same school), interested in design and lead a transformational process of the institution and its educational practices, that allow a better connection of the educational project with the conditions of a changing world and students already citizens of the XXI century.

During the diploma, each team will be part of:

- Online courses with tutors that support the learning process. These courses will be worked on schedules that are convenient for the students.
- Synchronous workshops to share experiences and visions with other schools' teams.
- Monthly mentoring dedicated to support the development of their own project of school transformation, focused on deep learning of students, through the implementation of active methodologies for learning.

MAIN OBJECTIVE

To develop competencies in school management teams and teachers. to start and lead a process of school transformation focused on students' deep learning.

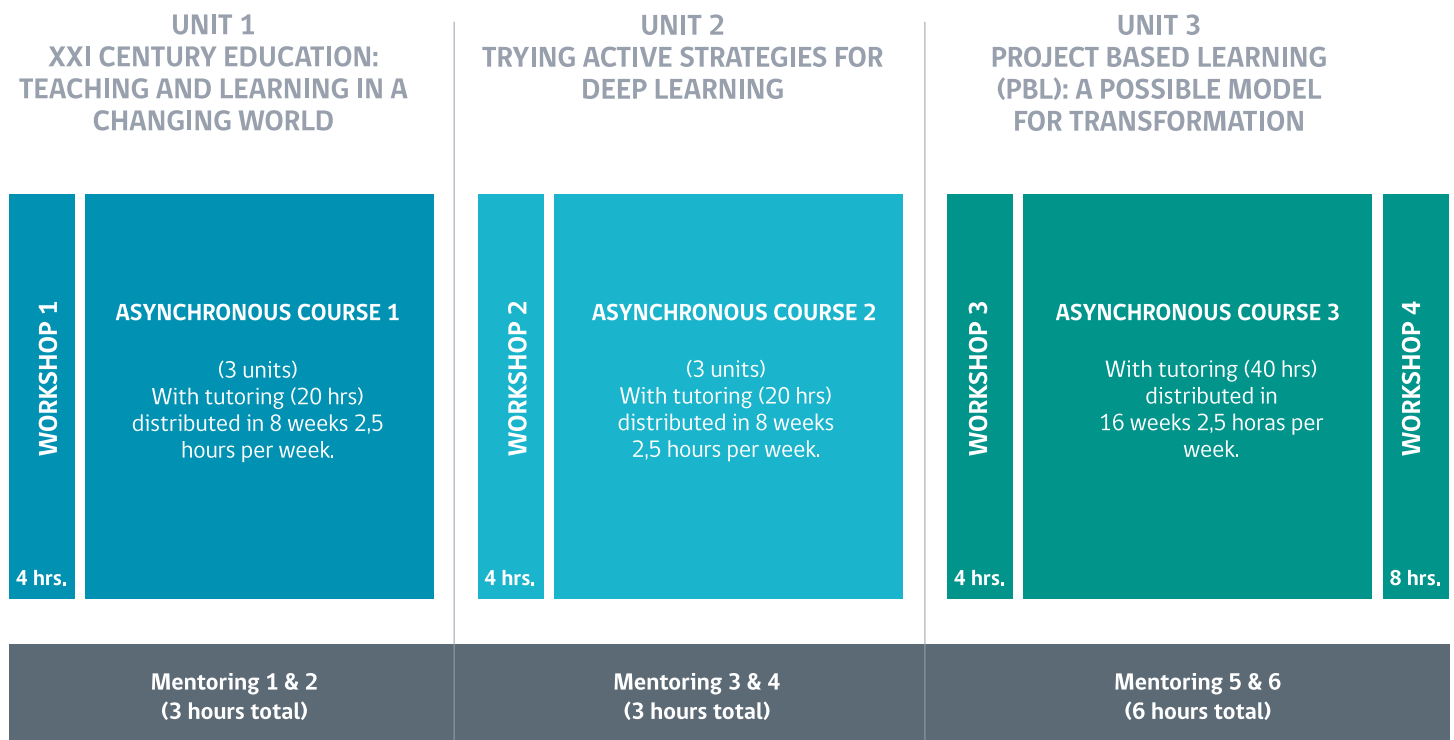
3. Oriented to
